

## Murieston Village Hall

Despite enormous effort from trustees of Murieston Initiative to keep Murieston Village Hall under community management, West Lothian Council decided to take back control of the hall. ## The Future

We are still keen to progress towards a quality community-owned building in future. As part of the community centre review, we identified a number of unresolved issues with the current hall: age of building, remediation costs, energy costs, lack of road access, parking, broadband availability, and the potential for parking charges to be imposed at the station. We decided that our community would be better served by looking at an alternative location for a future building.

The preferred site is at the junction between Murieston Road and Murieston East Road. Please come to our AGM to contribute to future proposals.
